THE 'B' BADGE ENDORSEMENT

The 'B' Badge endorsement can only be issued if the applicant has already qualified and applied for a Gliding certificate with the 'A' Badge endorsement.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Before attempting this test the candidate must have carried out the 'A' Badge requirements.
2. The candidate must be alone in the aircraft.
3. The test must be carried out under the supervision of BGA Official Observer or Instructor, who must complete and certify the reports overleaf. The evidence must be by a barograph trace to the satisfaction of an Official Observer, or alternatively may be continuous visual observation.
4. The candidate must carry out a soaring flight at or above the height of the previous lowest point after release for a continuous period of a least 5 minutes, followed by a normal landing.
5. The candidate must have a reasonable knowledge of the Rules of the Air, including rules appertaining to controlled airspace, prohibited areas etc.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

1. This completed form, together with the appropriate fee, must be sent to the British Gliding Association. Barograph traces need not be sent.
2. Applicant's gliding certificate must be forwarded with this form, together with One signed passport photograph (unless already forwarded).
3. The corresponding lapel badge (2 white gulls on blue enamel) may be purchased (£4.50)
4. All cheques and postal orders must be made payable to the British Gliding Association and crossed.
